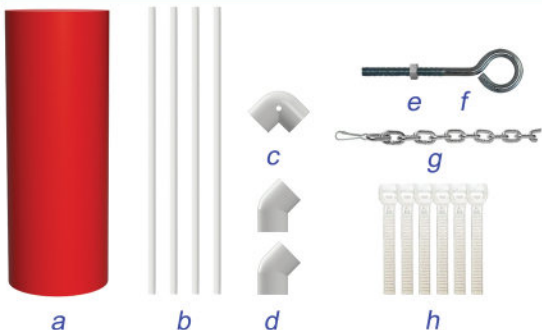




Premium Brooder Home Setup Instructions

FIVE EASY STEPS

PRODUCT LIST

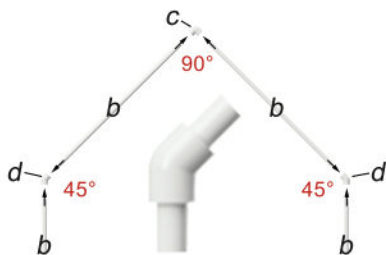


- a - corrugated plastic roll
- b - (4) 18" Pipes
- c - 90° fitting
- d - (2) 45° fitting
- e - nut
- f - eye bolt
- g - 10" chain w/ 2 clips
- h - (6) cable ties

STEP ONE:

Place pipe for lamp hanger on flat surface and attach pipe to fittings. Press fittings on **snuggly**.

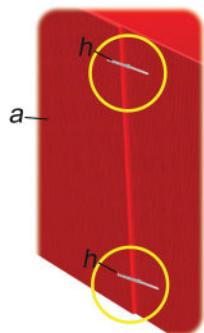
For added safety, apply pvc cement. Before adding heat lamp, ensure that all fittings are securely put together.



STEP TWO:

Unroll red corrugated plastic and place with smooth surface facing in and fasten ends together with included cable ties.

Do not overtighten cable ties as this can tear or warp corrugated plastic.

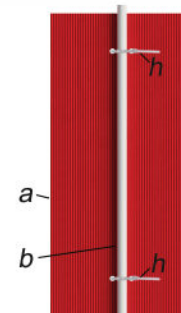


STEP THREE:

Line up lamp hanger with holes in the red corrugated plastic on both sides and attach with the included cable ties on outside of brooder wall.

Do not overtighten cable ties as this can tear, or warp, corrugated plastic.

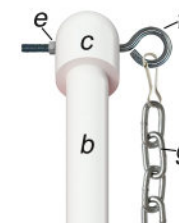
Use hands to gently crease corners to help form the rectangular shape.



STEP FOUR:

Attach included eye bolt and chain to the 90° fitting in order to hang your heat lamp.

The chain is used to raise or lower the height of your heat lamp to help raise or lower temperature.



STEP FIVE:

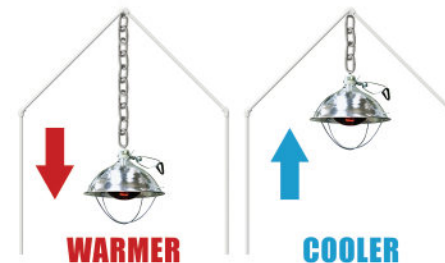
Set temperature in the Premium Brooder Home. (Measure temperature directly under lamp at floor level).

- If chicks huddle in a clump under light, temperature is too cool.
- If chicks are spaced comfortably directly under heat lamp, temperature is just right.

Days 1-2: 101°F-105°F.

Days 3-7: 95°F

Days 8+: Lower by 5° each week until temperature reaches 70°F-75°F



NOTE:

Brooder is intended for:

- 10-15 chicks up to 4 weeks
- 25 chicks up to 3 weeks

Curvature in corrugated plastic after setup is normal and should not effect use.

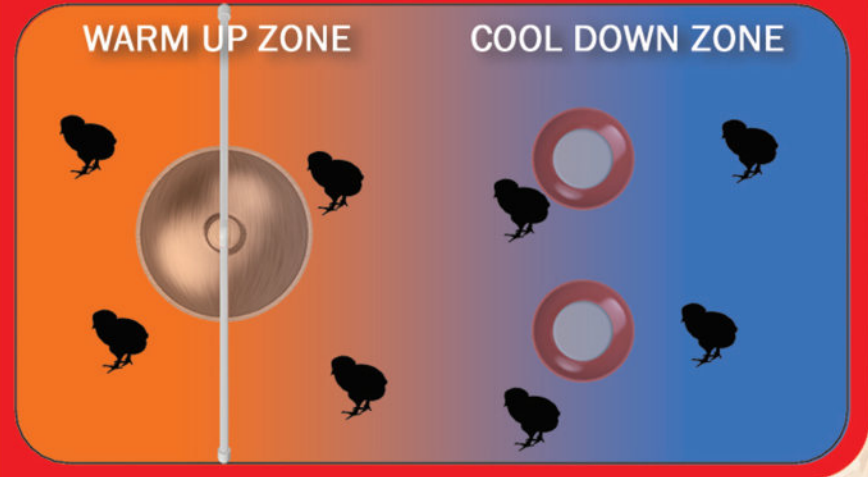
105° is the recommended temperature in the "WARM UP ZONE" the first 2 days after chicks are received through the mail.
